HIE ROLE

Allow providers to submit data to CMS with the click of a button through becoming a **Qualified Registry or Qualified Clinical Data Registry (QCDR)**.

Build trust by providing a validated analytic solution that complies with measure requirements and QRDA III format to improve the accuracy of reporting.

Prevent practices being blind sighted by lagging utilization data by providing real-time information across the ecosystem about when and where care is sought out.

Gain deeper insights through report and dashboards views at the aggregate, measure, patient and provider level.

Put data in the hands of clinicians by providing gap reports that display care management and patient engagement opportunities to proactively provide the right care.

Successes of the original CPC model highlighted the critical role that health information technology partnerships play in driving meaningful change. HIEs hold the longitudinal record and the technology functionality to be the solution that meets payers' need for holistic data, as well as practices' need for actionable information to drive affordable, high quality healthcare.
